

EXECUTIVE PROTECTION & TACTICAL MEDICINE RESPONSE (EPTMR) (16 Hours)

COURSE OVERVIEW:

Executive Protection & Tactical Medicine Response (EPTMR) is a two-day, 16-hour course that is designed for both current Executive Protection (EP) specialists and those entering the field assigned to high- or low-value principals. Participants will develop mission-critical skills through comprehensive instruction, hands-on instruction, and scenario training. EPTMR integrates various protective movements, tactical firearm applications, and Tactical Medicine based on current Tactical Emergency Casualty Care (TECC) guidelines.

COURSE TOPICS:

- Professional standards, demeanor, and principal relations
- Advance preparation and threat assessment
- Security planning, threat mitigation, and evacuation
- Communication and coordination during walking movements
- Use of force, de-escalation, and legal consideration for handgun deployment
- Multi-rep scenarios combining protection, tactical medicine, and evacuation under stress

SKILLS TRAINING:

- Tactical Medicine skills including:
 - Hemorrhage control
 - Airway management
 - Penetrating chest trauma
 - Medicine on the move
- Precision shooting drills including:
 - Shoot/No-Shoot Drills
 - Shooting in principal-centric settings

SCENARIO TRAINING:

- Rotating, multiple repetition scenarios that combine protection, threat mitigation, and tactical medicine in principal-centric settings.
 - o Students will be evaluated under stress, including force-on-force scenarios
